Wounds that are located in the "junctional" areas of the body, where the extremities meet the torso, make it impossible to place a traditional tourniquet. Several devices have been approved by the Committee on Tactical Combat Casualty Care (CoTCCC) for combat use. While civilian uses are still being investigated it is important to understand how these devices work.
