



WHY ?




- A patient treated under the STROKE protocol must be entered in the STROKE system to receive the proper care, transport, and interventions with ATCC & the EMSP routing the patient to the best available hospital.



Resources to Treat

- ED
- CT Scan
- Read CT Scan
- Determine Ischemic or Hemorrhagic
- Doctor decision to give drug, transfer, or treat locally



STROKE SYSTEM DATA

SECONDARY TRIAGE (PATIENT ROUTING)

- Based upon patient vitals, entry criteria, hospital availability, transport time.
- ATCC and EMSP make the decision.
- Best chance the patient has is transport to a Stroke Center the first time.
