


Checklist Inspection Sequence



- 1) Overall Appearance
- 2) Operator Compartment
- 3) Exterior: Operator's Side
- 4) Exterior: Front
- 5) Engine Compartment
- 6) Exterior: Passenger's Side
- 7) Exterior: Rear
- 8) Patient Compartment
